Carers Assessments - Have You Had One?

Most Carers have a legal right to an assessment of their own needs. It is your chance to discuss with the social services department of your local authority what help you need with caring. You can discuss any help that would maintain your own health and balance with other aspects of your life, such as work and family. Social services uses the assessment to decide what help to provide.

Carers Assessments allow you to apply for certain services from Social Services such as Occupational Therapy, Respite, Direct Payments and Care Packages. For more information about Carers Assessments or to request a form please ask your social worker or call the Carers Centre where we will be happy to send you a form and to help you to complete it. Carer Quality of Life Measuring Tool

A new manual to measure the quality of life of adult Carers was launched on Wednesday 16 February 2011. The Adult Carer Quality of Life Questionnaire (AC-QoL), published by The Princess Royal Trust for Carers, in association with the University of Nottingham, is a simple 40-item instrument which measures Carers' quality of life in eight domains: support for caring; caring choice; caring stress; money matters; personal growth; sense of value; ability to care; and carer satisfaction. Barnet Carers Centre has begun to use this tool to measure change and impact of support provided to our Carers. Data from completed questionnaires will eventually demonstrate how and if the intervention (support) affects each domain.

To support our services Carers can request the questonnaire which can be completed over the phone with one of our carer support outreach officers.

In October 2010 the Rapid Response Project was established to set up a process and procedure to provide a rapid response to Carers where the caring situation is at risk of breaking down.

The Rapid Response Project Team membership was formed from the health service, Barnet Council and Barnet Carers Centre.

The Project culminated in March 2011 with two presentations to over 150 people outlining the response that Carers can expect from both the statutory sector and voluntary organisations within Barnet.





Getting Here

We are one minutes walk from North Finchley Bus Depot. The following buses pass the Centre: Routes 82, 134, 221 and 460.

West Finchley, Northern Line is the nearest tube and is approximately a 20 minute walk.

Meeting Rooms For Hire
