Influenza Vaccination

Influenza Vaccination will be available from the beginning of October for all patients who:

- aged 65 or over
- are pregnant
- have a serious long-term health condition such as: asthma, COPD, diabetes, heart disease, kidney disease
- are very overweight (BMI of 40 or above)
- are the main carer for an elderly or disabled person
- Children aged 2 and 3 on August 31 2018 that is, children born between September 1 2014 and August 31 2016

Walk-In Clinics will be held in early October 2019 Please keep a look out for clinic dates.

An annual seasonal influenza vaccination provides the best protection against an unpredictable virus and we recommend all eligible patients attend for their vaccination. However, if you decide not to have the vaccination please let us know so we can enter this on your medical records. You can do so by **phone**, **email** or **letter**.
